

Adjectives

Use

Adjectives tell you more about people and things.

They are *short*.

The shops are *busy*.

Form

Usually adjectives go before the noun, not after it.

bright colours.

new clothes.

Adjectives can go after the verb *be* and *feel*.

Her jacket is *new*.

I feel *tired*.

If you use two more adjectives they usually go in this order.

For more than one colour use '*and*'

They have		<i>big</i>	<i>old</i>	<i>blue and grey</i>		cushions
