The twenty-four-hour clock is often used on bus and train timetables.

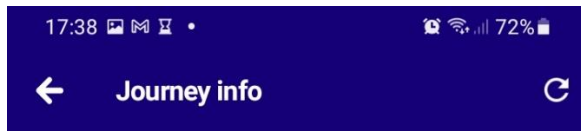
