



Liquid Nitrogen Aftercare

Liquid Nitrogen produces damage to your skin to treat the spot(s) you and your doctor have discussed.

The expected response is skin swelling, redness, scabbing and crusting. Sometimes there is clear or slightly yellowish fluid. This typically lasts 7-10 days. An area of light red may last several weeks. Bruising and pigmentation can also occur.

Rarely a blister forms. If a blister occurs, a bandage can be applied and changed daily.

In a small number of people, a light/white or dark spot can last months or longer. This is rare and is more common in people with more richly pigmented skin/darker skin tones.
