Shall the School District of the City of Pontiac, County of Oakland, State of Michigan borrow the sum of not to exceed One Hundred Forty-Seven Million Dollars (\$147,000,000) and issue its general obligation unlimited tax bonds, in one or more series, for the purpose of paying for the cost of the following projects:

**Building and Site Sinking Fund Tax Renewal
County of Oakland, Michigan**

This proposal, if approved by the electors, will renew the authority last approved by the electors in 2016 and which expires with the 2020 levy, for the School District to levy a building and site sinking fund tax at the reduced rate of 0.80 mills from the previously authorized rate of 2.87 mills.

Absentee ballots are available for all elections; registered voters may contact the Pontiac Clerk's Office for an absent voter ballot.

To comply with the Help America Vote Act (HAVA), voting instructions will be available in audio format and in Braille. Arrangements for obtaining the instructions in these alternatives formats can be made by contacting the city clerk in advance of the election. All polling locations are accessible for voters with disabilities.
