TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF THE CITY OF PONTIAC

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that any qualified elector of the City of Pontiac who is not already registered, may register to vote at the office of the City Clerk; the office of the County Clerk; a Secretary of State branch office, or other designated state agency. Registration forms can be obtained at mi.gov/vote and mailed to the City Clerk. Voters who are already registered may update their registration at www.expressSOS.com.

The last day to register in any manner other than in-person with the office of City Clerk is **Monday, February 24, 2020.**

After February 24, 2020, anyone who qualifies as an elector may register to vote in person with proof of residency (MCL 168.492) at the Pontiac Clerk's office, located at 47450 Woodward, Pontiac, MI 48342 at the following times:

- Regular business hours: Monday – Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
- Saturday, March 7, 2020 from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.
- Sunday, March 8, 2020 from 10:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.
- Election Day, Tuesday, March 10, 2020 from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

Shall the School District of the City of Pontiac, County of Oakland, State of Michigan borrow the sum of not to exceed one hundred forty-seven million dollars (\$147,000,000) and issue its general obligation unlimited tax bonus, in one or more series, for the purpose of paying for the cost of the following projects:

**Building and Site Sinking Fund Tax Renewal
County of Oakland, Michigan**

This proposal, if approved by the electors, will renew the authority last approved by the electors in 2016 and which expires with the 2020 levy, for the School District to levy a building and site sinking fund tax at the reduced rate of 0.80 mills from the previously authorized rate of 2.87 mills.
