TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF THE CITY OF PONTIAC

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that any qualified elector of the City of Pontiac who is not already registered, may register to vote at the office of the City Clerk; the office of the County Clerk; a Secretary of State branch office, or other designated state agency. Mail-In Registration forms can be used and found at mi.gov/vote and mailed to the City Clerk. Voters who are already registered may update their registration at <https://onlineservices.michigan.gov/ExpressSOS/>.

The last day to register in any manner other than in-person with the office of City Clerk is **Monday, October 19, 2020.**

After October 19, 2020, anyone who qualifies as an elector may register to vote in person with proof of residency (MCL 168.492) at the Pontiac Clerk's Office, located at 47450 Woodward, Pontiac, MI 48342 at the following times:

- Business hours: Monday – Thursday from 8:30 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.; Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
- Saturday, October 24, 2020 from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.
- Sunday, October 25, 2020 from 10:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.
- Friday, October 30, 2020 from 8:30 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
- Saturday, October 31, 2020 from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
- Sunday, November 1, 2020 from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
- Monday, November 2, 2020 from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
- Election Day, Tuesday, November 3, 2020 from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
