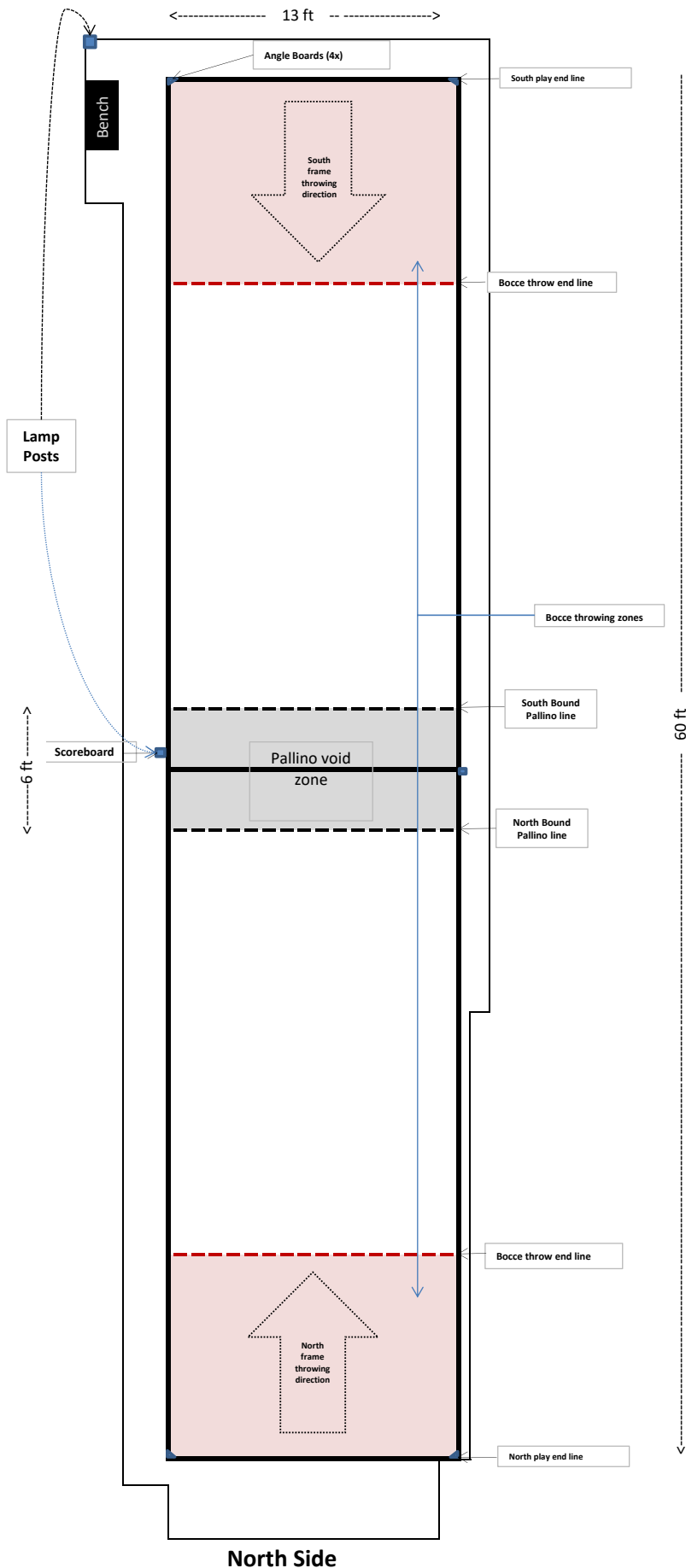

Bocce Model Court



The Bocce Court

Court Dimensions:

- Approximately 777 sq ft of playing surface.
- 350 sq ft of playing area per frame play.

The Game:

- Each match will be played in teams of two.
- Playing teams will determine which will start first (coin toss).
- Referee will review "rules" and requirements which includes the proper foot ware. (See signage posted on the court).

Playing items:

- 4 Bocce balls measuring 4 1/2 inches in diameter weighing either 2 3/4 lbs or 2 1/8 lbs each (your choice) and a Pallino.
- **Red or Green** spandex tank tops to identify the two teams playing, to be removed after the game for the next team match.

Playing Rules:

- the game is played in alternating "frames" (two frames for south and north throwing directions).
- Throwing of Bocce balls and Pallino must be made in each corresponding Bocce throw zones. The Pallino must clear the Pallino void zone by clearing their respective Pallino line (i.e., for South bound throws, the Pallino must clear the South Bound Pallino line and visa versa for North bound throws).
- the winning team of each frame will initiate the throw of the Pallino and first Bocce ball in the following play. This sequence will continue through out the entire game.

Scoring:

- Each frame play can score between 1 o 4 points.
- Scoring is determined by a referee and is updated on the Scoreboard after each completed frame. The winner of the game will be determined when the target has been attained by at least 2 points. In tournaments we use a 9 point taget to detrmine the winner.

Why play bocce?

Bocce is the best form of entertainment. Bocce is not only a game but a "sport". It offers the tremendous health and social benefits with the sophistication of appling unique strategies as commonly found in bowling and billiards. Boccetta is Bocce reinvented with the intent to demonstrate its beauty in providing an ambiance of family, food and fun for all!
