GENERAL CAR DEMURRAGE RULES AND CHARGES

ITEM	SUBJECT	APPLICATION
SECTION 1		
40	DEMURRAGE CHARGES	<p>On cars subject to demurrage charges after expiration of free time allowed (See Item 60), the following charges per car, per day, or fraction of a day, will be made until the car is released.</p> <p>\$25.00 per day for the first two days. \$30.00 per day for the next two days. \$50.00 per day for each day thereafter.</p> <p>The applicable charge will accrue on all Saturdays, Sundays and holidays (See Item 70) subsequent to the first chargeable day, including a Saturday, Sunday or holiday (See Item 70) immediately following the day on which the first chargeable day begins to run.</p>
SECTION 2		
50	EMPTY CARS ORDERED OR APPROPRIATED FOR LOADING BUT NOT USED	<p>When a car so ordered and placed is not used, and no advice from the party who ordered the car has been received within twenty-four (24) hours, exclusive of Saturdays and Sundays, demurrage charges will start from the first 7:00 A.M. after car is placed and will be charged until the car has been removed from the loading location.</p>
SECTION 3 - EXPLANATION OF TERMS		
60	FREE TIME - STRAIGHT AND AVERAGE AGREEMENTS	<p><u>LOADING</u> - Cars for loading will be allowed twenty-four (24) hours free time. Free time begins at the first 7:00 A.M. after the car is constructively or actually placed (See Item 80), and notification is given (See Item 90).</p> <p><u>UNLOADING</u> - Cars for unloading will be allowed two (2) working days free time (See Item 100).</p>
70	HOLIDAYS	<p>Wherever reference is made to "holidays", it shall mean only the days listed below.</p> <p>New Year's Day - January 1 Washington's Birthday - Third Monday of February. Memorial Day - Last Monday of May. Independence Day - July 4 Labor Day - First Monday of September. Thanksgiving Day - Fourth Thursday of November. Christmas Day - December 25</p>
80	PLACEMENT	<p><u>ACTUAL PLACEMENT</u> - Actual placement is made when a car is placed in an accessible position for loading or unloading or at a point previously designated by the consignor or consignee.</p> <p><u>CONSTRUCTIVE PLACEMENT</u> - When a car consigned or ordered to a private track, an industrial interchange track, or an other-than-public-delivery track cannot be actually placed because of a condition attributable to the consignor or consignee, such car will be held at destination, or if it cannot reasonably be accommodated there, at an available hold point and notice shall be sent (See Item 90) or given the consignor or consignee that the car is held (naming the hold point if not held at destination) and that this railroad is unable to effect placement; however, if car is placed on the private track, industrial interchange track or other-than-public-delivery track serving the consignor or consignee, the car shall be considered constructively placed without notice.</p>
90	NOTIFICATION	<p>Notification by BSOR and/or industry of arrival or release of cars will be:</p> <p>A. In writing by fax, U. S. Mail or otherwise; B. By personal or phone communication, or; C. By delivery of cars to designated industry track.</p>
100	WORKING DAYS	<p>Whenever reference is made to "Working Days", it shall mean any Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, or Friday that a car is actually or constructively placed (See Item 80) as of 7:00 A.M., excluding holidays</p>
110	DEMURRAGE CHARGES ON OWNERS/LESSORS CARS	<p>BSOR will charge demurrage upon receipt of owners/lessors written request on all cars whose alphabetical reporting marks end in "X" and/or any car where BSOR is required to pay a per diem time charge.</p>
