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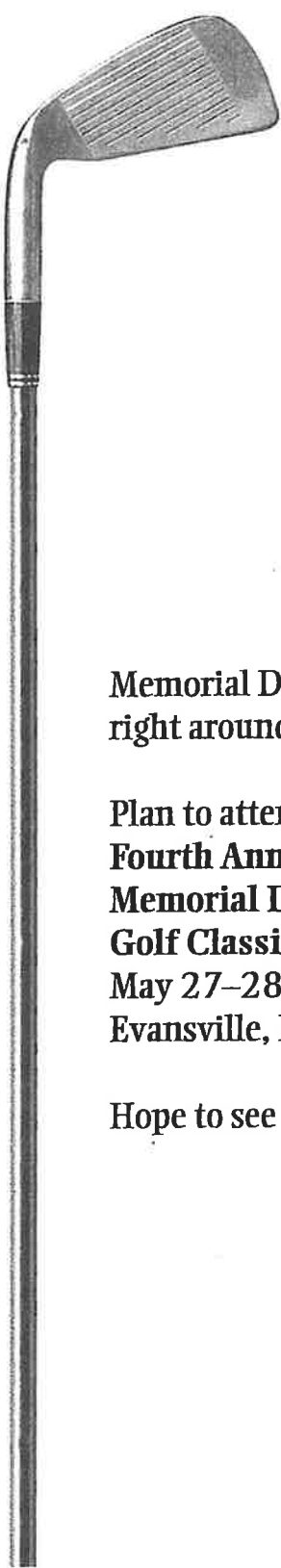

FOURTH ANNUAL MEMORIAL DAY GOLF CLASSIC TOURNAMENT RULES

1. USGA Rules apply with the following additions:
 - play will be two-person scramble unless there is an odd number of participants, in which case one team will consist of three players;
 - each player is allowed one mulligan per nine holes, which may be used at any time on the golf course.
2. Partners will be chosen based on the average of their submitted scores (see formula in *Golf Tournament News*, Vol. 1). Each participant is encouraged to submit an 18-hole score played after January 1, 1995, and before May 27, 1995.
3. In order to ensure tee-off times, entry forms must be received no later than May 13, 1995.
4. Entry fee is used to provide prizes and food for the awards ceremony. Prizes will be awarded for, but are not limited to, longest drive, closest to pin, lowest (winning) score, and best-dressed golfer.
5. Additional t-shirts will be available (in limited quantities) at the awards ceremony for \$7.
6. Green fees will be approximately \$20, which includes a shared riding cart.
