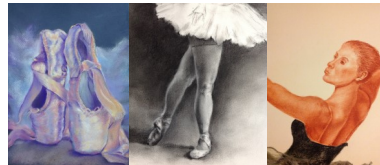

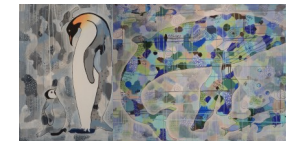
**'My Maitland' - A Solo Exhibition
