### Materials List

*Paint and canvas will be supplied.*

#### *You will need to bring:*

- A4 sketchbook or larger
- Small spray bottle – say an old atomiser from hair spray etc
  - Pencils – B & 4B
  - Kneadable putty eraser
- Brushes – a selection of flat & round acrylic brushes with one flat at least 2cm wide. One old brush for glue. Cheap shops sell brushes in packets of 3 or so for a reasonable price
- \$2 shops have packets of brushes with various sizes for acrylic or watercolour.
- 1 black and 1 white Posca pen 2mm. Available from Officeworks and Eckersleys
- Tissues or baby-wipes/rags
