In this series of workshops, renowned local artist David Oberdorf will guide you through the basics of drawing, starting with how to choose your drawing materials and papers, exercises to develop controlling your pen/pencil, tips on how to draw trees, foliage, people, pets and buildings using perspective.

One of the main focal points of this class will be the use of camera obscura – a method which has been used by artists for hundreds of years and saves hours of guesswork and measuring, and provides an accurate likeness, both in proportion and detail. This is one of the techniques that David uses to achieve the amazing perspective and real-life renderings of his works.

Lesson 1 - Introduction: Choices; drawing materials and papers

Lesson 2 - An exercise to develop controlling your pen/pencil

Lesson 3 - How to draw trees and foliage

Lesson 4 - Using Camera Obscura (image projection)

Lesson 5 - How to draw buildings using perspective

Lesson 6 - How to draw people and pets

Lesson 7 - A subject to draw and helpful feedback on your work
