It will also cut insurance cost if it sells. Director Collins made motion to approve sell of 2008 F-350 BT 396. Seconded by Director Bryant. No discussion. Passed unanimously.
- 4. Approval to accept bid from GVFD for \$20,000.00 for BT 396. NAFD received one bid from GVFD for \$20,000.00. Chairman Bailey made motion to approve and accept the bid from GVFD. Seconded by Director Brown. No discussion. Passed unanimously.
- **5. ANNOUNCEMENTS** There was a Badge Pinning Ceremony after the regular board meeting.
- 10. ADJOURNMENT Chairman Bailey moved to adjourn the meeting and Director Collins seconded it. Passed by unanimous decision. Motion carried. The meeting was adjourned at 6:14 p.m.
