Chess Policies and Procedures

Registration: Registration is completed **ONLY** upon receipt of a signed registration form and check made payable to **Chess Masters of Houston**

Pick Up: All children must be picked up by 4:25pm at carpool or walk up.

CONDUCT/DISCIPLINE: In order to provide a safe and nurturing environment in which to teach Enrichment classes, students must exhibit appropriate behavior. Children enrolled in chess classes are expected to follow the HISD Code of Conduct required at Rogers. Children who fail to conduct themselves according to this standard will be given a warning and their parents will be notified of their misconduct. Continued misconduct will result in notification to Rogers's administrators and/or suspension from the Chess Program. Children suspended from the chess program for misconduct will not be entitled to a refund of any tuition, fees, or registration paid.

NOTIFICATION: It is important that you notify the school office in writing or via e-mail if your child will be absent for chess.

Tuesdays: All the students play in 2 in-house mock tournaments per semester. They are grouped in sections appropriate to their ability and play one round per week. At the end of every 5 weeks, trophies are presented to the winners.

Wednesdays: Beginner and intermediate classes are offered for Kinder to 3rd grade students. Students are divided into groups based on their skill level and assigned a coach for the entire semester.

Fridays: Beginner, intermediate and advance classes are offered for grades K-8th and for advance elementary students. Students are divided into groups based on their skill level and assigned a coach for the entire semester.
