

ANNUAL REPORT FOR THE 2020-2021 SCHOOL YEAR





From The Year of The Student to The Year of The Teacher to The Year of the Parent/Family

For the 2019-2020 school year, The Year of the Student, we kicked off The Lean On Me Project by implementing a pilot program at Brookside Middle School that focused on student services, such as our 1-on-1 mentoring program and our lunch group mentoring program. Due to Covid-19, we then transitioned our mentoring program to an online platform where we started to provide Sarasota Military Academy with online 1-on-1 mentoring. We were tasked with graduating 15 students. We accomplished the mission as 14/15 graduated on time.

For the 2020-2021 school year, The Year of the Teacher & Personal Wellness, we focused on the administration, teachers, and support staff as stress levels were high from the transition to online learning. We cared for our professional community with the following initiatives: The Pay It Forward Lunch Program, The Headshot Initiative, Healing the Wounded Educator Book Circle, etc. Through these initiatives, we have cultivated close connection with Sarasota County School personnel which lead to collaborations at individual schools such as the Peer to Peer Mentoring Program, the 1331 Initiative, and the Lunch groups at Brookside Middle School. In addition, our connections lead to discussions about mental health needs at specific schools. The Lean On Me's response included direct investment of funds into other organizations, such as The Florida Center and First Step of Sarasota, to hire additional mental health counselors and SAPs (Student Assistant Professionals) in four schools.

As we enter the 2021-2022 school year, The Year of the Parent/Family, we roll out our signature initiative, The Parent Cafe - The Happiness Initiative. It will start online due to the current Delta variant of COVID-19 and will land in schools as it becomes more safe.

The data shown in this report represents Lean On Me's growth in the 2020-2021 school year. Projection of future growth and ventures are broadly explained further in this report.
