The Township needs 100% resident participation with the CDBG Financial Survey for Binsey Road and Stutz Road to qualify for road improvements. Notifications have been sent to the residents on these roads. Not all residents have responded.

The Phase II Bonniebrook Road Multimodal Transportation Fund Grant paving bids were opened at 2:00 p.m. on March 3, 2021 at the Township building. The results are as following:

Shields Asphalt Paving, Inc. \$1,142,885.67 Wiest Asphalt Products & Paving, Inc. \$1,249,237.95 Youngblood Paving, Inc. \$1,394,386.50

This an intergovernmental project with Jefferson Township. The bid will be awarded at the next Board of Supervisors public meeting on March 17, 2021 at 6:45 p.m. in order to give Jefferson Township an opportunity to review the results.

Larry Osche, Supervisor/Roadmaster, had a meeting with PennDOT representatives for the guiderails that are part of the Bonniebrook Road Multimodal Transportation Fund. The information will be reviewed by PennDOT for a determination.
