SOLICITOR REPORT

A status hearing is scheduled for the Gagliardi case.

Court filings has been made against the property owner of 145 Portman Road, Butler, PA due lack of property maintenance. The property owner was scheduled to attend the meeting to discuss the court filing but was unable to attend the meeting due to unforeseen circumstances. The court proceeding will continue.

The property owner at 246 Carbon Center Road attended the meeting to discuss his property clean-up. It was determined that Court proceedings will continue at this time. However, if substantial progress is made, the court proceedings may be placed on hold.

The updated Rails-to-Trail Agreement for the public sewage line location has been submitted to the Solicitor for review.

Willie Adams motioned to approve the Sewage Enforcement Officer's recommendation to update the Small Flow Sewage Treatment Agreements. Rick Green seconded the request. Motion Carried Unanimously.

Wendy Leslie will be contacted regarding the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) procedure for the distribution of the application for low-moderate residents financial assistance for the mandatory public sewage tap-in fee.

A Township resident requested for the Board of Supervisors to impose of a shooting ordinance. Cranberry Township has a rifle range ordinance for residential zoning districts. No action was taken at this time.

Rick Green motioned to write state representatives opposing the proposed sewage regulations and authorize the chairman to sign the letters. Willie Adams seconded the motion. Motion Carried Unanimously.

BONNIEBROOK ROAD PAVING BID RESULTS

Willie Adams motioned to renew the AED 2-year maintenance contract with Zoll Medical Corporation for \$799.00. Rick Green seconded the motion. Motion Carried Unanimously.

FINAL 2016 PETERBILT PAYMENT

The final installment payment for the 2016 Peterbilt truck will be paid from the General Fund.

SPRING-SUMMER NEWSLETTER

Rick Green motioned to approve the printing/mailing of a Spring-Summer newsletter. The newsletter will be approved by the Supervisors before being processed. Larry Osche seconded the motion. Motion Carried Unanimously.

PLANNING COMMISSION LAPTOP

Rick Green motioned to approve the purchase of a laptop for the Planning Commission not to exceed \$500.00. Larry Osche seconded the motion. Motion Carried Unanimously.

ENGINEER REPORT

There was nothing to report.

ROADMASTER REPORT

Roadmaster, Larry Osche, presented the following report:

- 1. Snow fencing was removed and placed in storage.
- 2. Potholes patched.
- 3. The road department vehicles were switched over from winter equipment to summer equipment.
- 4. Roads were broomed.
- 5. Grates were changed over on Geibel Road.

The Dirt Road, Low Volume Grant for Stutz Road is in the planning phase.

ADDITIONAL BUSINESS

Rick Green motioned to extend the Covid-19 State of Emergency for another week. Willie Adams seconded the motion. Motion Carried Unanimously.

Rick Green contacted Butler City Police for police services approximately two weeks ago. Butler City Police prefer 40 hours a week coverage. The Township prefers less hours. Butler City Police have not responded to the less hours request.

Saxonburg Police are agreeable to a 6-month trial period. Saxonburg council approved a draft Police Services Agreement. Rick Green motioned for the Township's Solicitor to draw-up a draft Police Services Agreement for Saxonburg Police to provide police services in Summit Township. Larry Osche seconded the motion. Motion Carried Unanimously.

The Tax Collector requested to not re-send updated tax cards to properties that have the Fire Hydrant Tax added by Butler County error for taxes less than \$2.00. Butler County will be contacted to see if this allowed.

OPEN TO THE FLOOR – PUBLIC PARTICIPATION.

Dave Barry presented a request from the Herman Volunteer Fire Company Officers to meet with the Township Supervisors to discuss the operations of the fire company.
