The Summit Township Board of Supervisors public meeting was held on Wednesday, February 18, 2026 at the Summit Township Municipal Building, 502 Bonniebrook Road, Butler, PA.

**CALL TO ORDER**

David Barry called the meeting to order at 6:45 p.m.

Larry Osche motioned to approve February 4, 2026 regular public meetings minutes as presented. David Barry seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Disbursements included engineering fees for the Act 537 Plan public sewage project, road salt, and general operating expenses.

Larry Osche motioned to approve the Treasurer Report as presented. Rick Green seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

**GENERAL FUND INVOICES APPROVAL**

Larry Oche motioned to approve the payment for Bradigan’s, Incorporated invoice 184010 for diesel fuel for \$2,433.92. Rick Green seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Herman Volunteer Fire Company paid Brighter Side \$1,947.10 for a generator transfer switch. Larry Osche made a motion to pay Herman Volunteer Fire Company \$973.55 for half the cost of the switch. Rick Green seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Larry Osche motioned to approve the payment for Clearfield Custom invoice 704 for the 2024 Mack truck steps repair and replacement for \$540.00. Rick Green seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Larry Osche motioned to approve the payment for Compass Minerals invoice 161643 for 69.36 tons of road salt for \$6,559.38. David Barry seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Larry Osche motioned to approve the payment for Elliott's Tire Service invoice 117100 for 2024 Mack truck rim and tire for \$1,070.74. Rick Green seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Larry Osche motioned to approve the payment for Higher Power Organizing invoice 000001 for the subdivision files organizational project for \$446.25. Rick Green seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Larry Osche motioned to approve the payment for Stephenson Equipment invoice W0167818 for the 2022 Ford F-550 snowplow hose repair for \$541.01. Rick Green seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

#### **SUMMIT AUTHORITY PAYMENT REQUEST**

David Barry motioned to approve the Summit Authority for the payment request to pay on their behalf the LSSE Civil Engineers and Surveying invoice 202600985 for engineering fees for the public sewage project for \$8,291.65. The Authority will reimburse the Township upon receiving funding. Rick Green seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

#### **TOTH SUBDIVISION**

Summit Township's planning commission submitted a recommendation letter for the Toth subdivision plan at 149 Rennick Road, Butler, PA that is in Summit Township and Jefferson Township. The Township's engineer and Butler County planning commission reviewed the plan as well.

The Supervisors reviewed the plan and recommendation letter of approval. David Barry motioned to approve the Toth subdivision at 149 Rennick Road, Butler, PA as administratively correct. The plan will be signed after Jefferson Township's approval and signatures are obtained. Larry Osche seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

#### **SOLICITOR REPORT**

The Solicitor had nothing to report.

#### **AGRICULTURAL SECURITY**

Heasley's Nursey submitted a request to remove parcel 290-2F14-A2F-0000 from agricultural security.

Larry Osche motioned to approve the agricultural security property removal request. David Barry seconded the motion. Larry Osche voted "yes". David Barry voted "yes". Rick Green abstained. Motion carried.

#### **RESOLUTION 2026-03 ACT 537 PLAN REVISION**

Larry Osche motioned to approve Resolution 2026-03 for the Act 537 Plan revision for the Summit Authority to be a PA American Water bulk customer. Rick Green seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

#### **TAX COLLECTOR BOND**

David Barry motioned to approve the Mitchell Insurance invoice for the tax collector's 4-year bond for \$131.41. Larry Osche seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

#### **BUTLER COUNTY COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENT (COG) MEMBERSHIP**

Larry Osche motioned to approve the payment for the Butler County Council of Government (COG) 2026 membership for \$100.00. David Barry seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

#### **ENGINEER REPORT**

The Toth subdivision plan was reviewed.

**TOWNSHIP VEHICLE**

Larry Osche motioned to approve Tri-County Truck Center contract for a 2027 Mack truck cab and chassis, and Stephenson Equipment contract for a dump body, snowplow, spreader, and hydraulics for the truck. Rick Green seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

**ROADMASTER REPORT**

The Roadmaster presented the following report.

1. Checking roads and removal of debris.
2. Equipment maintenance performed.
3. Salting of road.

Route 38 and Route 68 overhead lighting have a possible cut wire from a construction project. Once the snow is melted, this will be repaired.

**ADDITIONAL BUSINESS**

David Barry announced the Supervisors had an executive session via telephone on February 18, 2026 at 9:00 a.m. regarding a fabric cold storage building. No decisions were made.

Larry Osche announced that David Barry and himself went to Clinton Township to view their garage on February 18, 2026 at 10:00 a.m. No decisions were made.

Compass Minerals road salt costs were discussed.

David Barry motioned to recess the meeting into executive session at 7:40 p.m. with no decisions to be made. Larry Osche seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.
