Larry Osche motioned to approve for payment Frank Hartle invoice 387197 for the installation of a garage door opener for \$375.00. Rick Green seconded the motion. Motion Carried Unanimously.

Rick Green motioned to approve for payment Jerich Insurance Agency invoice 2006 for the 6<sup>th</sup> installment of the Township's liability insurance for \$1,330.00. Willie Adams seconded the motion. Motion Carried Unanimously.

Rick Green motioned to approve for payment Jerich Insurance Agency invoice 2032 for the 9<sup>th</sup> installment of the Township worker's compensation policy for \$837.00. Willie Adams seconded the motion. Motion Carried Unanimously.

Larry Osche motioned to approve for payment Larry Grabe invoice 983123 for the trimming of trees on Osche Road, Bish Road and Keck Road. Trees were also trimmed on Chicora Road that were obstructing the view of Lick Hill Volunteer Fire Company station light for \$2,500.00. Rick Green seconded the motion. Motion Carried Unanimously.

Larry Osche motioned to approve Suit-Kote invoice 68905 the application of MC-70 oil on the shoulders of Township roads. Rick Green seconded the motion. Motion Carried Unanimously.

#### **GENERAL FUND CD RENEWAL**

Rick Green motioned to renew the General Fund CD for 6 months. Larry Osche seconded the motion. Motion Carried Unanimously.

#### **POLICE COVERAGE**

Rick Green spoke to a Butler Township Police Lieutenant and Manager regarding part-time police coverage for the Township. They are willing to meet with the Supervisors to discuss possible police coverage. A list of items that the Township would like to have for police services will be emailed to Butler Township manager.

# **BINSEY ROAD SUIT-KOTE INVOICE DETERMINATION**

Larry Osche motioned to approve for payment from the General Fund Suit-Kote invoice 65017 for the Binsey Road oil application for \$8,552.70 contingent upon 120 tons of stone at the Township building remain. Rick Green seconded the motion. Motion Carried Unanimously.

#### **ROADMASTER REPORT**

Roadmaster, Larry Osche, presented the following report:

- 1. Equipment maintenance.
- 2. Tree trimming traffic control.
- 3. Road projects.

Larry Osche motioned to fix the water drainage issue on Philmar Drive. Willie Adams seconded the motion. Motion Carried Unanimously.

A driveway at Philmar Drive was concreted onto the Township's right-of-way. The road project will require a portion of the concrete to be removed. It will be replaced with pavement.

# **ADDITIONAL BUSINESS**

Rick Green motioned to extend the Covid-19 state of emergency for another week. Willie Adams seconded the motion. Motion Carried Unanimously.

Willie Adams motioned that Lockaton Junk Yard has 30 days to comply with the Township's Agreement for parked vehicles. If this is not done, the Township will pursue civil proceedings. Rick Green seconded the motion. Motion Carried Unanimously.

# **OPEN TO THE FLOOR – PUBLIC PARTICIPATION.**

Robert Ray requested an update on the fume issue with the Township building. The Road Department will foam around the edge of the garage and the furnace will be blocked off with an outside draw.

A mirror on Bonniebrook Road for a driveway to access the road is being shadowed by trees. The Supervisors will look at the trees.
