Rick Green motioned to award the tree trimming bid to Olar's Tree Service & Shaping for \$29,075.00. Willie Adams seconded the motion. Motion Carried Unanimously.

## TAX COLLECTOR TRAINING

### TRAFFIC LIGHT MAINTENANCE PROVIDER

Bronder Technical Service is no longer providing traffic lights maintenance service. The Township's contract is in effective until December 31, 2017. Larry Osche presented a list of traffic light maintenance providers.

Traffic Systems & Services provides traffic light maintenance for Butler Township and Center Township. Roxann Stickney will contact Traffic Systems & Services for their availability to provide traffic light maintenance service to the Township

### **ENGINNER'S REPORT**

Michael Elisco presented the following engineer report.

- 1. Act 537
  - A. The plan was submitted to the DEP for review. Administrative completeness was addressed by the Engineer.
  - B. It was determined that the engineer will obtain quotes for the Phase 1 Archaeological Study and Geotechnical Survey.
  - C. The aerial photos are ready for the mapping of the data. The cost will be \$25,875.00.
  - D. It can be requested of Penn Vest to include the re-cooperation of the design cost.
  - E. After approval of the Act 537 is received from the DEP, the sewage authority should be established.
  - F. It will take approximately 6 8 weeks to incorporate the sewage authority.
- 2. Whenever stormwater management plans are approved, the property owner is required to pay all outstanding invoices.

Rick Barnett will contact Roxann Stickney to establish a procedure for Senate Engineer to submit of their review invoices.

### **ROADMASTER REPORT**

Roadmaster, Larry Osche, presented the following road department report:

- 1. Worked on Geibel Road drainage.
- 2. Removed seal coat signs and CDBG signs.
- 3. Cut grass.

Letters requesting the removal of reflectors from Kemar Drive and Saxoburg Road right-of-way were mailed. It was determined that that the reflectors will be removed for the winter maintenance season and will be permitted the remainder of the year due to the mail service driving on the grass.

The posts on the bend on Brinker Road do not belong to the Township.

Rex Energy and Stonehenge Appalachia LLC pipe company has Thorn Run Road bonded for a gas well. Trucks are damaging the road. Larry Osche has contacted Rex Energy and received no response.

The pipe project on Geibel Road pipe should be completed in approximately four days.

Leo Rosenbauer of Butler County Conservation District confirmed that a road with less than 500 cars per day is eligible Dirt and Gravel funding. Larry Osche will do traffic counts on Keck Road, Binsey Road and Fallecker Road.

The engineer for the McGrady Hollow Road CDBG project and Russell Standard Corporation met with Larry Osche to discuss an overlay option for the road. Larry Osche would like for the engineer to meet with Joe Wiest to discuss the milling of the road.

## **ADDITIONAL BUSINESS**

Willie Adams requested for the Planning Commission to review the limiting of the number of dogs per household in the zoning ordinance.

There was not questions or comments from the floor.
