Willie Adams seconded the motion. Motion Carried Unanimously.

COX LOT LINE REVISION

The Supervisors reviewed the Chris Cox and Melanie Cox lot line revision plan for 125 Kemar Drive, Butler, PA, and the Township's Planning Commission recommendation letter of approval. Butler County Planning Commission reviewed the plan and had no comments.

Willie Adams motioned to approve the Chris Cox and Melanie Cox Lot Line Revision at 125 Kemar Drive, Butler, PA as administratively correct contingent all fees are paid for the lot line revision. Rick Green seconded the motion. Motion Carried Unanimously.

PLAN REVIEW FEES

The Township's Fee Schedule will be updated at the next public meeting to include the engineer review fee of \$150.00 for residential minor subdivisions/lot line revisions be paid at the time the application is submitted. If the engineer review fee exceeds \$150.00, the applicant is responsible for the additional costs.

Willie Adams motioned to approve the advertisement of the 2023 American Rescue Plan budget, Capital Fund budget, Fire Hydrant budget, General Fund budget, Sewage Escrow budget, Sewage Permit Fund budget and State Fund budget. Rick Green seconded the motion. Motion Carried Unanimously.

ENGINEER REPORT

The engineer submitted review letters for the West Penn Power transmission line project and the Cox lot line revision.

ADDITIONAL BUSINESS

Emergency Management Coordinator, David Barry, contacted the American Red Cross regarding a blood drive. Availability for a blood drive is early 2023.

October 14, 2022. at 10:00 a.m. an informational meeting at the Township building regarding Medicare insurance options. No decisions were made

Immediately following the insurance informational meeting on October 14, 2022, the Supervisors met with property owners at Dittmer Road, Butler, PA regarding a water issue. No decisions were made.

Immediately following the Dittmer Road, Butler, PA informational meeting on October 14, 2022 the Supervisors met with property owners at Lyn-Mar Drive, Butler, PA regarding a water issue. The water issue has no impact on the Township. It is a private matter amongst the property owners.

October 19, 2022 at 10:00 a.m. an informational meeting was held with the Township's Solicitor, Michael Gallagher, Summit Academy's attorney, Jim Norris, Herman Volunteer Fire Company President, Larry Shuler, and the Township's Secretary regarding Summit Academy's fire safety, general business trends, and the public sewage project. No decisions were made.

October 24, 2022 a zoom meeting is scheduled with the Supervisors, Summit Authority board members, Township's engineer, Penn Vest, and State representatives regarding financing for the public sewage project.

Willie Adams motioned for the adjoining properties at Chicora Road, Butler, PA that have disabled vehicles, junk and debris be placed on the property clean-up schedule. Rick Green seconded the motion. Motion Carried Unanimously.

OPEN TO THE FLOOR – PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

A resident from Ringneck Lane, Butler, PA and Route 422 East, Butler, PA attended the meeting regarding fireworks debris coming onto their house roofs and property from a neighboring property. The Township does not have a fireworks ordinance.
