There were no questions or comments from the floor.

OCTOBER 19, 2022 PUBLIC MEETING MINUTES

Rick Green motioned to approve for payment Saxonburg Police services from October 1, 2022 through October 28, 2022 for \$2,380.52. Larry Osche seconded the motion. Motion Carried Unanimously.

SLAUGHENHAUPT CONDITIONAL USE HEARING DECISION

Rick Green motioned to approve the conditional use for Matthew Slaughtenhaupt for a greenhouse at 881 Bonniebrook Road, Butler, PA based upon the conditional use hearing and recommendation letter of approval from the Township's Planning Commission. Larry Osche seconded the motion. Motion Carried Unanimously.

SPORTSMAN SUPPLY

A reminder letter was sent to Tyler Kovach of Sportsman's Supply Company requesting an update on the status of the removal of the storage containers at 245 Freeport Road, Butler, PA. The deadline is November 30, 2022. No response has been received. The Solicitor will be informed of the no response.

SUMMIT AUTHORITY ALTERNATE BOARD MEMBER

Rick Green motioned to nominate Jim Henry as an alternate board member to the Summit Authority subject to approval at the next Summit Authority board meeting. Larry Osche seconded the motion. Motion Carried Unanimously.

QUICKBOOKS TRAINING

Rick Green motioned to approve Roxann Stickney to view an Intermediate QuickBooks training webinar at home. Larry Osche seconded the motion. Motion Carried Unanimously.

PLANNING COMMISSION REQUEST FOR SOLAR PANELS, SLOPING & GRADING REQUIREMENTS

Rick Green motioned for Senate Engineering Company to research with the Planning Commission ordinance requirements for solar panels, sloping, grading, impact feeds, and electric charging stations. Larry Osche seconded the motion. Motion Carried Unanimously.

FEE SCHEDULE UPDATE FOR PLANNING FEES

Rick Green motioned for the Fee Schedule to include that engineer \$150.00 review fee will be paid at the time the minor subdivision or lot line revision application is submitted. If the review fee exceeds \$150.00, the applicant must pay the remaining balance before final approval is granted. Larry Osche seconds the motion. Motion Carried Unanimously.

NEW BUILDING

Larry Osche motioned to obtain professional quotes for the partial design of the Township building. Rick Green seconded the motion. Motion Carried Unanimously.

It will be evaluated to have a walkway between the office and garage.

ROADMASTER REPORT

The Roadmaster presented the following report:

- 2. Cutting of grass performed.
- 3. Patching of potholes.
- 4. Equipment maintenance performed.

Water Conservation District will conduct a property survey for the Stutz Road cross pipe project.

Regis Karch inquired if the building inspector has the right to change the Township's building requirements. It was determined that the building requirements are to be followed.
