#### **ENGINEER'S REPORT**

The engineer submitted the attached report. The following items were discussed.

- 1. Rick Barnett contacted the DEP regarding the annual NPDES Permit annual fee since the scope of the project has changed. The DEP determined the annual fee of \$1,000.00 must be paid regardless of the project scope change.
- 2. The conservative cost of the current plan \$24 million dollars. The most feasible option would be to phase the project. Phase I would service the East Herman area for \$11 million dollars.
  - A modification to the Act 537 Plan will be required to phase the project.
  - Wetlands and archeological studies will have to be completed due to moving pipes.
  - Willie Adams motioned to phase the project and keep Phase 1 cost at \$11 million dollars subject to applying for various grants. Phase I plant location will be at Herman Road (East of Simon Drive) to service East Herman area. Rick Green seconded the motion. Motion Carried Unanimously.
- 3. Grants listed on the engineer report will not be pursued at this time due to re-scoping the project. The application requirements will not be met by the submission deadline.
