Is a permit necessary???

If you are in doubt whether a permit is necessary for your home improvement/building project, please call the Township office at 724-285-1168 to find out. Any project begun without a permit will be required to cease and desist work immediately until a permit is obtained and the fee is doubled. Permits are typically issued within 14 days of submission and expire after one-year. Please obtain your permit in advance of the start date for your home improvement/building project.

Burning Requirements

Burning is permitted in Summit Township from 6:00 a.m.—8:00 p.m. Monday through Saturday. No burning is allowed on legal holidays. All fires must be extinguished with no smoldering. Do not burn in the ditch or Township right-of-way.

Recreational fires are permitted on Sunday and legal holidays.

If you are having a controlled burn, please call the 911 non-emergency number at 724-284-7769 and the Township at 724-285-1168 to report the date of the burn.
