Representative Marci Mustello PROPERTY TAX—RENT REBATE CLINIC

If you pay property taxes or rent your home, you may be eligible for a rebate. Representative Marci Mustello is conducting a clinic to assist residents with completing the application.

The Property Tax— Rent Rebate Program benefits eligible Pennsylvanians age 65 and older; widows and widowers age 50 and older; and people with disabilities age 18 and older.

The income limit is \$35,000 a year for homeowners and \$15,000 annually for renters, and half of Social Security income is excluded. Spouses, personal representatives or estates may also file rebate claims on behalf of claimants who lived at least one day in 2021 and meet all other eligibility criteria.

The maximum standard rebate is \$650, but supplemental rebates for qualifying homeowners can boost rebates to \$975.
