**CALL TO ORDER**

David Barry called the meeting to order at 6:45 p.m.

Disbursements include Herman Volunteer Fire Company annual fire engine contribution, fuel, road salt, tires for the 2016 Peterbilt, and engineering fees for the Act 537 Plan for public sewage.

Rick Green motioned to approve the Treasurer Report as presented. Larry Osche seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

**GENERAL FUND INVOICES APPROVAL**

Larry Osche motioned to approve the payment of Elliott’s Tire Service invoice 117340 for 2016 Peterbilt truck tires for \$1,778.92. Rick Green seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Larry Osche motioned to approve the payment of First Inservice invoice 021926-06 for the 2016 Peterbilt truck universal joints repairs for \$1,283.56. Rick Green seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Larry Osche motioned to approve the payment of Higher Power Organizing invoice 000002 for the subdivision files organization project for \$382.50. Rick Green seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Larry Osche motioned to approve the payment of Higher Power Organizing invoice 00003 for the subdivision files organization project for \$446.25. Rick Green seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Rick Green motioned to approve the payment of Jerich Insurance Agency invoice 4473 for the Township worker’s compensation insurance for \$1,212.00. David Barry seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Rick Green motioned to approve the payment of Jerich Insurance Agency invoice 4467 for the Treasurer’s bond for \$1,875.00. David Barry seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Larry Osche motioned to approve the payment of State Worker’s Insurance Fund invoice for the Herman Volunteer Fire Company worker’s compensation insurance for \$1,249.00. Rick Green seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Larry Osche motioned to approve the payment of Stephenson Equipment invoice P0977218 for signs for \$1,594.00. Rick Green seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

**LIQUID FUELS FUNDING**

Liquid Fuels allocation was received for a total of \$223,842.64.

**HERMAN VFC EARNED INCOME TAX CREDIT**

Rick Green motioned to ratify the approval of the Herman Volunteer Fire Company’s earned income tax credit for Teagan Raypush, Larry Shuler, and Robert Shuler. The Secretary crossed referenced the eligibility list. All individuals were eligible. Larry Osche seconded the motion. Rick Green voted “yes”. Larry Osche voted “yes”. David Barry abstained from voting. Motion carried.

**HERMAN VFC ANNUAL FIRE ENGINE CONTRIBUTION**

Larry Osche motioned to approve the annual contribution to Herman Volunteer Company for the new fire engine for \$20,000.00. Rick Green seconded the motion. Rick Green voted “yes”. Larry Osche voted “yes”. David Barry abstained from voting. Motion carried.

**SEAL COAT PROJECT ADVERTISEMENT**

Larry Osche motioned to authorize the advertisement for the seal coat project. Rick Green seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

**CRACK SEAL PROJECT**

Larry Osche motioned to purchase crack seal materials from Sealmaster. There is no machine rental fee. Rick Green seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

**ROADMASTER REPORT**

The Roadmaster presented the following report.

1. Patching potholes.

2. Cleaning and checking roads.
3. Equipment maintenance performed.

An accident at the intersection of Route 68 and Route 422 damaged a traffic light pole. An insurance claim will be submitted.

Herman Volunteer Fire Company has requested the removal of blinking yellow lights for the former Lick Hill Volunteer Fire Department and Herman Volunteer Fire Company. The lights are located on Chicora Road and Herman Road, which are State Roads. PennDOT is reviewing the request.

#### **ADDITIONAL BUSINESS**

David Barry announced the Supervisors had an informational meeting on March 4, 2026 at 1:00 p.m. with a contractor regarding a garage. No decisions were made.

Bob Ray thanked the Township for fixing a sign.

Representatives from East Butler Baseball Association gave an overview of the number of children registered and plans for the baseball grounds.
