DISC JOCKEY Jimmy Savile's secret love jetted into Dublin today to launch her latest record on the Irish pop market.

"I'll cry my eyes out over you," sings pretty 25-year-old Polly Brown, revealed as the one most likely to take over from "The Duchess" as the woman in the life of the famous disc jockey.

"The Duchess" — Jimmy's mother—who often accompanied him on the annual Herald/C.R.C. walks died six weeks ago, aged 85.

Yesterday, Jimmy and Polly, founder member of the Picketty Witch pop group, spoke about their romance at Bournemouth, Hampshire.

Polly posed for photographers at the office of Polydor Records Ltd., Middle Abbey Street, today. But she refused to elaborate on the publicised romance.

Asked about marriage, she said : "Sure, Jimmy would be great fun to settle down with, but I'm not sure if I could spend the rest of my life in a caravan. Still, maybe he'll put another storey on his mobile home."
