ESSENTIAL DUTIES

- Operates and maintains treatment processes and equipment in wastewater treatment facility.
- Operates and maintains the wastewater collection system.
- Performs daily plant duties including site housekeeping, measuring chemical usage, performing maintenance on wastewater treatment equipment and collecting water samples.
- Performs “On-Call” duties at the utility in response to problems related to the treatment plant and collection system.
- Operates and maintains wastewater systems located within the Fort Wayne area. Monitors operations including using SCADA.
- Ensures compliance with regulatory policies, procedures and rules.
- Completes customer service work orders and locate tickets.
- Updates and maintains appropriate system documentation of activities and closes work orders in the appropriate company system in accordance with departmental policies and procedures.
- Maintains awareness of operational conditions and/or identifies pending issues/problems, and notifies management recommending an appropriate course of action.
- Performs all tasks safely, professionally, and according all company policies and procedures as well as local, state and federal laws, rules, and guidelines.
- Attends training events and seminars to keep current with regulatory changes, become familiar with new technology, and keep current with Operator Continuing Education requirements.
