Vision

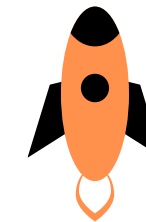
To empower underprivileged students by providing holistic educational opportunities, essential resources and life skills, ensuring a brighter future for every child.



Mission

To create a lasting impact in the lives of under-resourced children by:

- Supporting their education through sponsorships, workshops and essential donations.
- Collaborating with communities, donors and other NGOs to address systemic issues in education.
- Continuously expanding our reach and capacity to serve, with a focus on sustainability and inclusivity.



Goals

- Support underprivileged children to complete education.
- Provide Educational Resources to underprivileged children.
- Conduct comprehensive workshops to create self awareness and confidence in students.
- Build stronger collaborations with donors, corporates and other NGOs to expand our impact.

UNDER-PRIVELEDGED SECTOR IN INDIA

- **Population Below Poverty Line:** Approximately 22% of India's population lives below the poverty line, which translates to around 270 million people (as of the latest available data).
- **Access to Education:** Nearly 50% of children in India drop out before completing secondary education. Around 35% of children are out of school, with a higher percentage in rural areas.
- **Healthcare Access:** About 65% of the population in rural areas lacks adequate healthcare facilities. Infant mortality rate stands at 30.8 deaths per 1,000 live births.
- **Sanitation and Clean Water:** Approximately 40% of rural households do not have access to proper sanitation facilities. Nearly 160 million people lack access to safe drinking water.



OUR PROGRAM & INITIATIVES

- **KHUSHI:** Khushi marked our first event on 9th January 2016, celebrating the New Year and the beginning of our journey for a noble cause with the children of Gaondevi Vidyamandir, Thane. **Since 2016**, except for the lockdown years, Neev95 Trust has been organizing the 'Khushi' event to spread joy and cheer to children from under-resourced schools. This annual event, which started with a celebration at Gaondevi Vidyamandir, continues to bring happiness to young minds, featuring engaging activities like magic shows, creative workshops, delightful treats, creating memorable moments for the children.



OUR PROGRAM & INITIATIVES



- **Health Check-Up Camps for Student Well-Being:** Since 2018, our NGO has been organizing health check-up camps for the students of Gaondevi Vidyamandir, involving pediatricians, dentists and gynecologists, supported by our volunteers. Parents are counseled about their children's health, with medicines and treatments prescribed as needed. We aim to continue this initiative and expand it to more under-resourced schools.

OUR PROGRAM & INITIATIVES

Empowering Education by Supporting Students' Academic Journey with Financial Assistance: Student Support Program

The **Student Support Program** by Neev95 Trust aims to provide financial assistance covering up to 100% of school fees for underprivileged students. This initiative is designed to empower children from low-income families by ensuring they have access to quality education. Eligible students will be identified with the help of school principals, followed by thorough verification and interviews conducted by our team.

Neev95 Trust began this program in 2016, by reaching out to students in dire need of support by helping them financially to complete their education. From **2016-2024**, we supported **80 students**, referred by trusted sources and verified through rigorous background checks. These students, from institutions such as Navodaya English High School & Junior College, Maharashtra Vidyalay, New Girls High School, Aadarsh Vidyalay, Holy Angel School, Satish Pradhan Dnyansadhna College and so on, received financial aid totaling over **₹3,84,929** during this period. Our goal remains to empower students by ensuring uninterrupted education and promote overall well-being.

OUR PROGRAM & INITIATIVES

Education Essentials - Through Stationery Donations

Since 2023, we have been on a mission to support the education of underprivileged students in Thane district by providing them with essential school stationery supplies.

In **2023**, we started our journey by supporting **4 schools and 346 students** in Wada and Bhiwandi talukas, ensuring they had the basic tools they needed to continue their studies. Fast forward to **2024**, and we are proud to have expanded our reach, supporting **32 schools and 1,128 students** this year alone. That's a grand total of **32 schools and 1,474 students** whose educational journeys we have touched!



This initiative has been a collective effort, with the help of our generous donors, volunteers and community supporters.

Our goal is to support **95 schools** in the near future—and we plan to keep going even beyond that, helping shape a brighter future for these children, ensuring their education continues smoothly, no matter the challenges.

To promote healthy choices and habits, we also distribute dental kits and healthy snacks during these workshops. Each session and competition is designed to educate, empower and promote overall well-being.

OUR PROGRAM & INITIATIVES

Sports Spectacular: Since 2022, Neev95 Trust has been organizing Sports Day events for the students of Gaondevi Vidyamandir, an under-resourced school where Sports Day was once held on the streets. Thanks to the unconditional support of Signal Shala, we now book their playground every year, giving these students a proper platform to shine.

This initiative has brought immense joy to students and parents alike, and it has uncovered incredible athletic talent among the children. To nurture these talents, we hired a sports coach, and as a result, some students have participated in interschool competitions, even reaching the finals!

Inspired by these remarkable outcomes, we aim to extend this initiative to other underprivileged schools, empowering more children to realize their potential through sports.



PARTNERSHIPS AND COLLABORATIONS

Collaborating with Charitable Association of Greens Residents (CAGR) group, Neev95 Trust contributed to building toilets for under-resourced ZP schools in Thane District in 2023. CAGR group further collaborated also in paying school fees and donating fans and lights to needy schools.

Corporate Collaboration with ICICI Securities Ltd. for Annual Stationery Donation Drive: Since 2023, ICICI Securities Ltd., under their Avsar Initiative, has been a committed partner of Neev95 Trust in organizing an impactful Annual Stationery Donation Drive for underprivileged students in Thane District. Their enthusiastic volunteers have been instrumental in packing and distributing stationery kits, ensuring the drive's success. This collaboration, fueled by their dedication and the support of generous donors, has significantly enhanced the reach and impact of this initiative, enabling us to serve and empower countless students effectively.

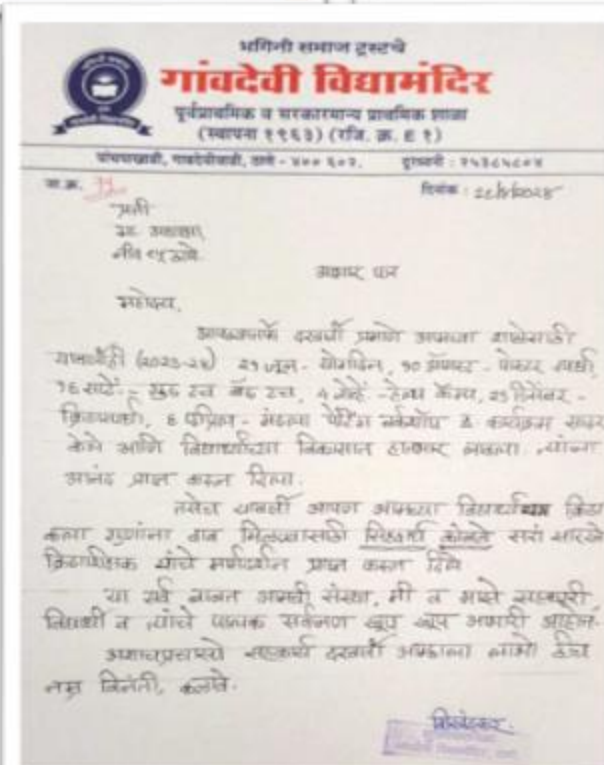
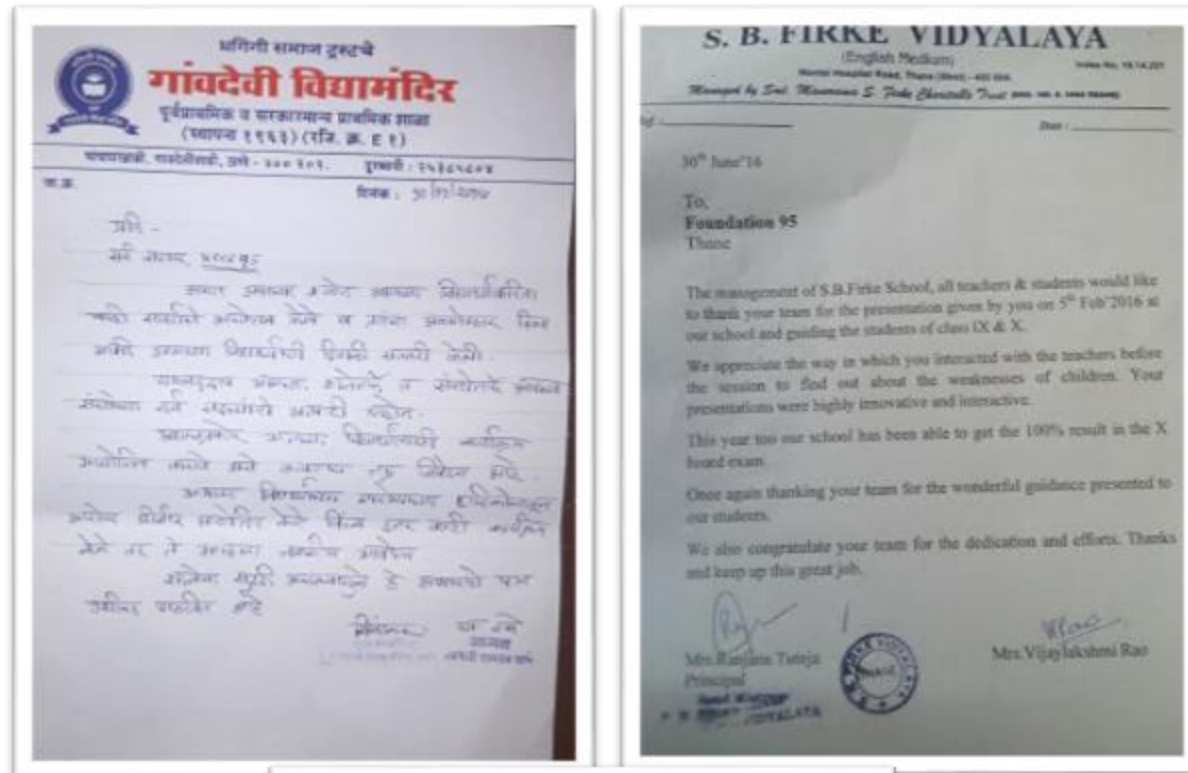

Strategic Roadmap (2025–2030)

Phase 1: Expanding Support to 95 Schools (2025–2027)

1. Increase Outreach:

- Identify under-resourced schools across rural and semi-urban areas of Thane.
- Focus on student sponsorship, essential resources (e.g., stationery, books, and hygiene kits) and school infrastructure development.

2. Strengthen Partnerships:

- Build stronger collaborations with donors, corporates and other NGOs.
- Leverage CSR initiatives (e.g., ICICI Securities' Avsar Initiative) to expand our impact.

3. Enhance Programs:

- Conduct comprehensive workshops like Good Touch vs Bad Touch, menstrual health and self-awareness across all target schools.
- Organize Sports Day events for more under resourced schools, replicating the success seen at Gaondevi Vidyamandir.
- Initiate skill development and arts programs to foster creativity and confidence in students.

4. Measure Impact:

- Establish a systematic process to monitor students' academic and personal growth.
- Regularly evaluate the effectiveness of programs through feedback from schools, parents and volunteers.

Strategic Roadmap (2025–2030)

Phase 2: Reaching Beyond 95 Schools (2027–2030)

1. Scale Up Operations:

- Expand operations to other districts within Maharashtra and beyond.
- Focus on tribal and rural areas where educational needs are critical.

2. Infrastructure Projects:

- Build or upgrade classrooms, libraries and sanitation facilities in schools.
- Equip schools with sports and arts infrastructure to promote holistic development.

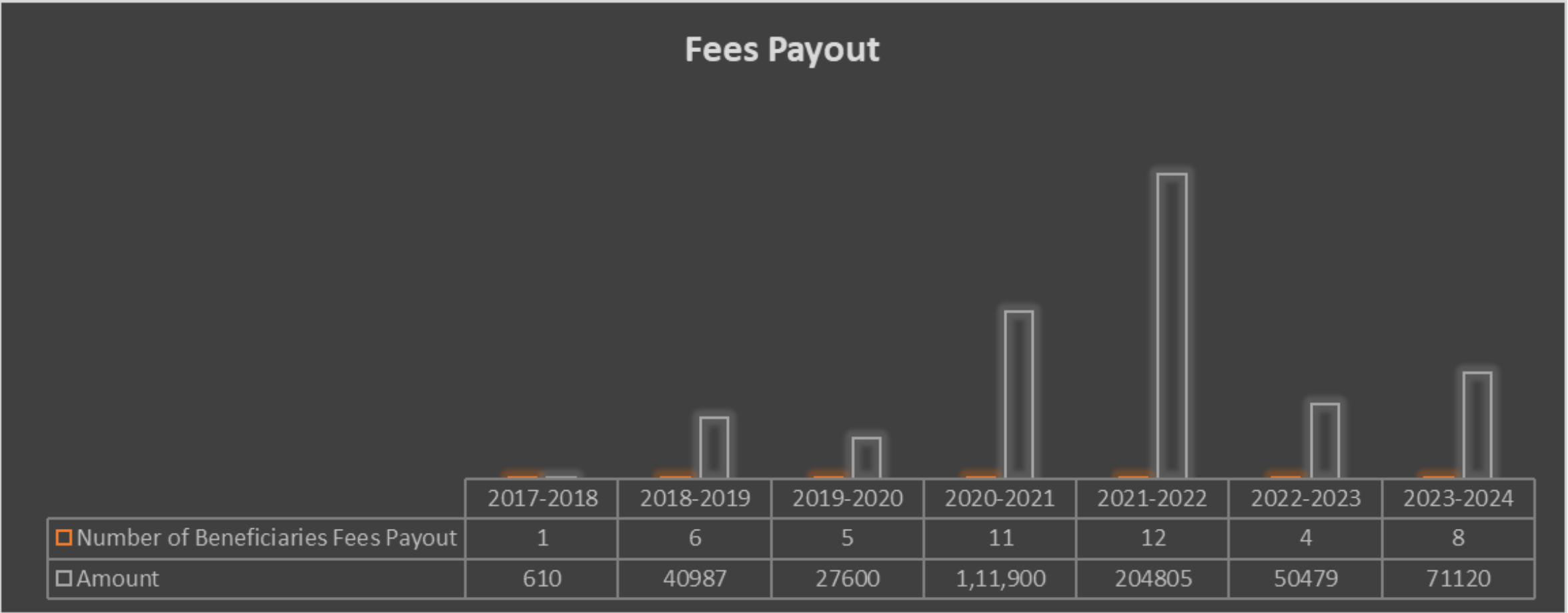
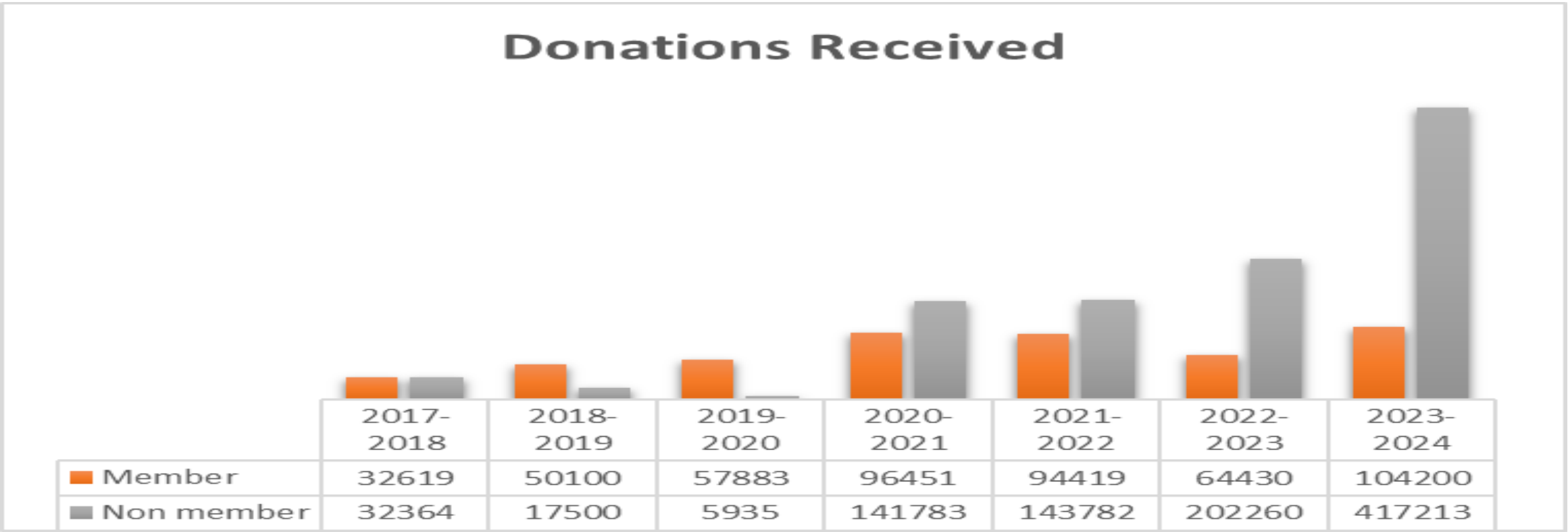
3. Broaden the Scope:
