It will equip the learner with the knowledge and skills needed to actively support a Competent Person (see National Safety Guide) in the delivery of pre-prepared sessions within a Surf Life Saving Environment.

- Demonstrate an understanding and knowledge of the roles, responsibilities, skills and techniques of a Surf Life Saving Sports coach and how to apply them whilst working under the supervision of a Competent Person (see National Safety Guide)
- Explain the principles of coaching and demonstrate how to prepare and maintain an equitable and safe coaching environment
- Demonstrate the principles of preparing, delivering and evaluating coaching session, including the preparation of equipment, facilities and participants, and supporting participant behavior and performance
- Demonstrate an understanding of basic guidelines of safeguarding and to provide children and young people with the best possible experience and opportunities in Surf Life Saving
