PACKAGE SERVICES:

LESSONS & TRAINING

- A "Session" may be any of the following: mounted training, lesson/instruction, groundwork, lunging, long-lining/ground driving, physical therapy, vet/bodyworker/farrier consult, or any other appropriate activity to benefit the horse. Trainer will work with client to determine appropriate schedule and type of work.
- Lessons run about 45 minutes.
- Packages will be billed electronically on the 20th and due on or before the 1st. Please have payment IN THE BOX on or before the 1st of the month to avoid any late fees. CASH or CHECK PREFERRED there will be a 2% convenience fee to recoup processing costs of taking payments electronically.
- Additional lessons that occur in 5-week months will be used towards any make-ups, but will **not** incur any additional fees.
- Missed lessons please allow a minimum of 48 hours' notice to receive a make-up lesson. Lessons canceled less than 48 hours in advance will be forfeited. Credits will be issued *only* if a make-up time cannot be accommodated by instructor within 30 days. **Please limit rescheduling as much as possible.**

NON-BOARDER SESSIONS: (No charge for haul-in or school horse use.)

- 1 Weekly Session (*based on 4 sessions per month)\$250/Mo.

BOARDER SESSIONS (Lessons, training or a combination of)

- 2 Weekly Sessions (*based on 8 sessions per month minimum board requirement)\$445/Mo.
- 4 Weekly Sessions (*based on 16 sessions per month)\$800/Mo.
- 5 Weekly Sessions (*based on 20 sessions per month)\$940/Mo.

FULL BOARD: \$715/Month Includes up to 4lbs daily of individually selected, high-quality grain, locally grown free-choice hay 24/7, a large box stall that is well-bedded, full turn out in good weather, blanket/sheet management, supplement & medication feeding (owner provided), parasite prevention management (de-wormer and sand-clear will be billed as administered), scheduling and holding for ROUTINE farrier, dental & vet care (non-emergency; vaccines and trims only – actual fees for services paid by owner), private walk-in tack locker, discounts on lessons, training and clinic fees, access to heated bathroom & heated observation lounge, manicured bridle path, regular on-site clinics, shows & other educational events. Owners live on site, experienced management team. Private, adult-only facility. Individual care and attention to each horse and rider. Free trailer parking.

NON-PACKAGE SERVICES:

VIDEO EVALS/CONSULTS: These are NOT live. Rider provides video (up to 60 minutes) and then we can either watch it back together (via 45 minute phone call) and start/stop while I talk you through my notes and suggestions and answer any questions OR you can receive written feedback with notes and several specific exercises (due at time of service) \$55/each

CLINICS: \$65-85/per ride – travel fees may apply. Minimum 4 riders. Due at time of service.

LEASING: Limited availability. All leasers must take a minimum of 8 lessons prior to starting lease to ensure it's a good fit and for the safety and welfare of both horse and rider. Lease fee includes use of horse facility, tack, blankets, supplements, farrier care and discounts on on-site clinics and special events. NO additional fee for using a leased horse for showing or clinics. Leasers are responsible for 1/3 of ROUTINE/Non-Emergent veterinary care. This includes annual dental, vaccinations, and other maintenance such as hock injections, Adequan, Equiox, etc., as appropriate. (Not to exceed \$500/year.) Leases will be signed for 6 months OR can be month-to-month for a \$50/month convenience fee. (Early cancellation fees apply, see contract for details.)

- PACKAGE A: 1 lesson + 2 practice rides: \$500/mo
- PACKAGE B: 1 lesson + 3 practice rides: \$625/mo
- PACKAGE C: 2 lessons + 1 practice ride: \$595/mo
- PACKAGE D: 2 lessons + 2 practice rides: \$720/mo

SHOW COACHING: \$65/day or \$115/weekend + expenses

"Day" refers to # of days actual show classes are held. This will include arrival day schooling, warm-up coaching, ring side coaching, test reading (if applicable), test review after, assistance with prep (as appropriate), logistics of travel, use of team tack room, group equipment, etc.

**Team tack room, lodging expenses, other travel expenses, etc. will be split between all showing parties and will be provided in advance. (If coach shows, they will also contribute to the split of expenses) If Team Trailer is used in lieu of hotel, rate will be billed at \$100/night. Overnight lodging in team trailer will be offered \$50/night (space limited).

DAY LEASE of SCHOOL HORSE: For use of horse for shows or clinics. Limited availability........\$75/day (waived if you are already leasing)

HAULING: TBD per trip – rates will depend on fuel prices, distance, number of loaded horses, etc. Prices will be quoted at time of booking. (Approximately \$2/loaded mile, round trip)

SCHOOLING SHOW JUDGING & RIDE A TEST CLINICS: From \$300/day (based on 8 hours) **I have attended the USDF "L" training programs as a participant in sessions A-C. I have **not yet tested** so am **NOT** an "L" grad. If your show requires an official "L" grad, I will not qualify. I have judged schooling shows with classes through 2nd level, both Dressage & Western Dressage.
