## 1 Year after PactAct: Highlightsbut more needed

#### according to whitehouse.gov: PACT Act:

- -To ensure veterans can receive high-quality health care screenings and services related to potential toxic exposures, the PACT Act expands access to VA health care services for veterans exposed during their military service.
- -The PACT Act codifies VA's new process for evaluating and determining presumption of exposure and service connection for various chronic conditions when the evidence of a military environmental exposure and the associated health risks are strong in the aggregate but hard to prove on an individual basis.
- -The legislation removes the need for certain veterans and their survivors to prove service connection if they are diagnosed with one of 23 specific conditions.
- -Established Presumption for Rare Respiratory Cancers
- -Raising Awareness of VA Benefits Related to Military Exposures:
- -Requiring Training for VA and Non-VA Providers: Health care providers and compensation and pension examiners sometimes do not have the training to understand or treat veterans' exposure concerns.
