I hope this message finds you well. Today, I am reaching out with a heartfelt request for your spiritual support as our church faces an urgent challenge. In October, we were counting on an infrastructure grant to help us replace our church roof and restore the parking lot—vital projects for the safety and well-being of our congregation and the community. However, due to unforeseen government issues, this grant has been paused for the Southside of Chicago, leaving us in great need. I'm often reminded of the story of Nehemiah rebuilding the walls of Jerusalem. Despite facing significant opposition and obstacles, Nehemiah remained steadfast in his faith and commitment to the task before him. His story encourages us to trust that, with God's help, even the greatest challenges can be overcome. In this same spirit, I believe

our church's restoration is possible, and we can fulfill our mission if we lean on faith and perseverance, just as Nehemiah did. In these times, I believe in the power of united prayer and faith. I am inviting you—my family and Facebook friends—to join our church in three hours of prayer and fasting

each day, for five consecutive days. Together, we will seek God's guidance, provision, and open doors for our church's complete roof tear off and parking lot restoration. Here's how you can participate:

1. Set aside three hours daily for prayer and fasting starting November 4, 2025, thru November 8, 2025, (choose a time that works best for you).
2. Lift our specific needs: Ask for divine intervention in securing the resources needed for the roof and parking lot and pray for favor and resolution regarding the paused grant.
3. Share encouragement: Send messages, scriptures, or words of hope to uplift one another throughout this spiritual journey.
