The Problem - No Best Practice

Exploring the query, "How to respond during an Active Shooter incident" online generates over 30 million results. This deluge of information has the potential to leave individuals feeling inundated and uncertain about the best course of action. Some organizations may even rely on the, "It'll never happen here" strategy rather than developing and implementing a plan.

Defining the Differences

The definition of an Active Shooter is constantly changing and evolving as government agencies and so-called experts continue to study these horrific incidents. The many definitions



of the term "Active Shooter" can include gang violence, domestic violence, and even suicides. These differences add to the public's confusion of the number of incidents and the statistics often cited by various reports and studies. For instance, consider the scenario where an assailant, armed with a gun, uses a knife to kill and injure his victims. Is this classified as an Active Shooter incident? The confusion deepens as the term "Active Threat" is used. An Active Threat can be defined as a perpetrator using a variety of weapons, to include a firearm, knife, pressure cooker bombs (Boston Marathon 2013), a vehicle (Nice, France 2016), or any other instrument to cause death or serious bodily injury. The term "Active Assailant" is used interchangeably with Active Shooter.


Lack of a Universally Accepted Best Practice


Numerous strategies, catchphrases, and acronyms have emerged to guide the public's response to Active Shooter incidents. You may be familiar with models like Run, Hide, Fight, or Avoid, Deny, Defend, and even acronyms like ALICE, CRASE, or ALIVE - the list is extensive. However, what remains unfortunate is the absence of a universally accepted best practice for responding to an Active Shooter incident. If you have undergone Active Shooter training, your approach could greatly differ from someone who received training elsewhere. While the intent behind these various strategies were well intended, none of them have solved, or even slowed down, the incidents of active shooters. The First step to stopping these acts of violence is recognizing each incident is different as it relates to location, environment, perpetrator's intent, people targeted, and the police response. A tailored approach for each situation is necessary!

Trending The Wrong Way

Utilizing FBI data, the chart presented below depicts the frequency of Active Shooter incidents in the United States spanning from 2000 to 2022. Within this period of 23 years, a total of 484 distinct Active Shooter incidents were recorded. While these figures might appear relatively low considering the standards set by different agencies, the prevailing sentiment is that we are witnessing an undesirable trend.

The P.R.O. Model

The Active Shooter Prevention Project's P.R.O. Model (Prevention, Response, & Options) focuses on PREVENTION first. Training our communities to better recognize red flags and warning signs is not enough. We also need to ensure there are reliable and anonymous reporting mechanism in place. This information would allow Threat Assessment Teams and trained individuals to evaluate the information and determine if further action such as intervention is warranted. We are setting the bar by leveraging the latest advances in technology, including artificial intelligence, to alert first responders of potential threats before the first shot is fired.

When prevention fails, a quick response is essential. For example, when shots are fired, our technology can provide the police with real-time information on the location of the assailant(s) as they move to different positions. This provides law enforcement the ability to better evaluate the situation and approach tactically.

The 4 P's

When we talk about Active Shooter incidents, there are four key factors to consider. These factors are: 1) The Place- where is the incident occurring? 2) The People – who is being attacked, and what is their level of training? 3) The Perpetrator – Who is the assailant, what is their motive, and what level of destruction do they intend to inflict on the community? 4) The Police – who is responding, how long will it take them to arrive on the scene, and are they ready, willing, and able to intervene? Most Active Shooter incidents are over within 5 minutes, and it normally takes the police anywhere from 0-8 minutes to arrive on the scene. Unfortunately, we are often reminded that response does not always equal rescue. We need to better utilize training, tools, and technology, to give the gift of time and save lives.


