The final order of play will be posted at the Chief Steward's Office. Competitors must check in with the Steward at each event. Failure to play at a scheduled time will result in disqualification for that event.

SANCTIONING:

All events, except where noted, are sanctioned by the EUSPBA and run according to its rules. Every solo competitor must be an individually registered member of the EUSPBA or of a reciprocating organization. Members of the reciprocating organizations must provide a copy of their registration card.

Competitors who conduct themselves in a belligerent, devious, or unsportsmanlike manner will be removed from the competition area and/or the grounds at the discretion of the contest committee (2 members of the Chief Steward's Office & 2 EUSPBA representatives)

The SCHG&F reserves the right to make changes to events as long as their actions are within the EUSPBA rules and are deemed to be in the best interest of the Scotland Connecticut Highland Games & Festival
