- 1. Please complete your application and email it to <u>njwclub@gmail.com</u> no later than October 15, 2024. Please include 3-4 pictures of the items you will be selling when emailing your application.
- 2. Once your application is approved, you will receive an email with payment instructions. Your registration is NOT considered complete until payment is received.
- 3. Doors will open on Saturday at 8:15 a.m. for set-up. All vendors must complete set-up by 9:45 a.m and stay until the end at 3:00pm. Tear down will begin at 3:00pm.
- 4. NJWC will supply vendors who purchased a table space with one table (\$35) and two chairs. Tables are 8ft in size.
- 5. Vendors renting an 8x10 ft open area space (\$60) will be provided with two chairs and NO table. This type of space is required for vendors with large/tall racks—limited availability. A table can be rented for \$10.
- 6. Spots will be assigned on a first-come (paid), first-serve basis, once you are approved.
- 7. There are limited spaces with electricity. Please indicate this need.
- 8. After unloading your product, you are expected to move your vehicle to the far end of the parking lot.
- 9. This is a not for profit event. No refunds will be given unless the event is canceled.
- 10. All vendors are responsible for bringing adequate change. We will not be able to make change for you.
- 11. Naperville Junior Woman's Club is not responsible for items left behind or unattended.
