

God's Love for Us

Sometimes we often think that God's love is a conditional thing. We think that He could not possibly love me because of things I have done in the past. The TRUTH is that God's love is unconditional. The Bible says that NOTHING can separate us from God's love- He always loves ALL of us regardless of our past (Romans 8:38-39). His love is not like our love, it is unconditional. He loves us but may be disappointed in our actions.

God created the infinite universe, our solar system, our planet, and the garden of Eden as our home in the beginning. He made this magnificent home for us so that He could love us and have a deep relationship with us. It is amazing to think that He did that just for us!

BUT he did all of this knowing that we would sin against Him. Sin is disobedience to God's instructions and will for us (1John 3:4). From BEFORE God created everything, He knew this would happen. God knows our thoughts before we even think them (Psalm 139:4). He knows

our thoughts and desires from the beginning of time, yet He still chose to create and love us because He wanted to have a relationship with us (just like you have with your family and friends).

HOWEVER, just because God loves us does not mean we have a relationship with Him. Our sins (shortcoming/ disobedience to His Word, the Bible) separate us from that relationship with Him (Isaiah 59:1-2). So if that is the case, How do we have a relationship with Him?

His Word says that sin is not allowed in Heaven~ so a sinful person can not spend eternity in heaven with God. In fact the Bible tells us that when we die on earth, our spirit goes to only one of two places- heaven or hell. That is a scary thought. If we are by nature sinful as the Bible says (Romans 5:12- ALSO see the study in this website about the Messiah parts 1 and 3) it means when we die we will go to hell. BUT God had a plan from the beginning of time to redeem us so that we can go to heaven and be with Him forever! In heaven, the Bible says, there will be no more tears (Revelation 21) but in hell there will be eternal gnashing of teeth and burning flames.

I don't know about you, but I want to be in heaven with a loving God! So how can that happen? God's plan for our redemption is forgiveness of sins through Jesus. The Bible says we must turn from our sinful, selfish thoughts and turn to Jesus. John 3:16-18 is a famous verse that tells us we have forgiveness through our faith and belief in Jesus. It tells us that Jesus came to save the world and not to condemn it~ boy if that is not love, I don't know what is). But if we do not believe in Him, we are condemned already. The Bible also says that **THE ONLY WAY** to heaven is through Jesus (John 14:6). That is God's rules, not man's.

Many people will say that the Bible is not real so hell is not real. Did you know that this is more scientific, historical, and archaeological evidence to support the fact that the Bible is real? You must be sure of that before you can believe Jesus is real.
