1. Our Commitment to Safeguarding

Safeguarding is a shared responsibility and is embedded in our culture, values, and day-to-day practice.

2. Who This Statement Applies To

This Safeguarding Statement applies to:

- All visitors and service users
- External organisations and individuals hiring rooms
- Staff, volunteers, and contractors while on site

It provides an overview of our safeguarding approach.

3. How We Safeguard People

We take safeguarding seriously and will:

- Promote a safe and welcoming environment
- Ensure staff and volunteers receive appropriate safeguarding guidance
- Respond promptly and appropriately to any safeguarding concerns
- Work in line with local authority and national safeguarding procedures

All safeguarding concerns, disclosures, or allegations are handled confidentially and reported through our established procedures.

4. External Organisations and Room Hire

Where activities are delivered by external organisations or individuals hiring space within the Hub:

- Those organisations are responsible for their own safeguarding arrangements
- They must ensure appropriate safeguarding policies, procedures, and DBS checks are in place where relevant
- Bradmore Green Community Hub CIC reserves the right to take action if safeguarding concerns arise on site

5. Reporting Concerns

If you are worried about the safety or wellbeing of a child, young person, or vulnerable adult while at the Hub, please report this immediately to a member of staff or the Designated Safeguarding Lead.

If someone is in immediate danger, please contact emergency services by calling **999**.
