Meeting Highlights

2017 Car Show Shirt Orders: Dick reported he currently has orders for 31 shirts including those to be given to Show Sponsors. There are decals for 35 shirts available. The business names will be screen printed on the back of the shirts. Miles raised a question about the cost of the shirts and what we are charging for them. Since the shirts were not sold at the show, those that will be sold will be to Club members. The statement was made at the August meeting,

"that by charging \$20/\$22 per shirt, we hope to break even on the shirt cost with the sponsor gifts included". The concern is whether we are charging members extra for these shirts in order to help pay for the sponsors gifts, an expense that should be considered a legitimate car show expense. Further discussion took place that included the belief that we would probably not plan to have show shirts made again next year. It was agreed to keep the price of these shirts at \$20./\$22. Any extra money made on the sale of these shirts would go to the Club treasury for future use, not to be considered as covering a show expense.

Wine Cruise Weekend: Dick & Evelyn reported that those members that attended the weekend event seemed to enjoy themselves. They visited several new wineries/breweries this year including a new brewery on Route 11B called Township 7 and another, Dark Island Spirits in Alex Bay. The suggestion was made that we consider participating in a boat tour/cruise next year and maybe stay in Alex Bay. Service at the hotel in Watertown was not as good this year. Space in the parking lot was not roped off for our cars as in the past.

Beer/Fall Foliage Cruise: It has been noted that a number of regular members are not available to participate in the cruise on October 7th. The decision was made to change the date of this cruise to Saturday, October 14th. We will meet at the A & W on Route 9 at 10 am and drive thru Keene. We will not plan to visit any breweries.


