

Honor Flight Donation Presentation: Several members met at the Keeseville VFW to present our donation check of \$2500.

Car Show 2020: Application to use the US Oval in 2020 has been completed and sent in. It will be voted on during the next session of the City council. A new 10 x 20 tent has been found. Dick brought in one of the supports for the group to see if they approved of the quality. Dennis has an idea to improve the sound system for making announcements at the car show. He has found a wireless speaker, receiver and a transmitter that will work with the DJ equipment that we currently hire for the event. He proposed to buy it and have it on hand with a possible loan out to Honor Flight to use at their events. The cost of the system would be \$1200 for 1 speaker, stand, transmitter, and receiver. We could add a 2nd speaker for a total of \$2120. This was tabled for more discussion at the next meeting. Ernie and Kathy were added to the committee.
