## **DO NOT BE AFRAID (33)**

<u>Genesis 43:23</u> - He replied, "Peace to you, do not be afraid. Your God and the God of your father has put treasure in your sacks for you. I received your money." Then he brought Simeon out to them.

<u>Genesis 46:3</u> - Then he said, "I am God, the God of your father. Do not be afraid to go down to Egypt, for there I will make you into a great nation.

<u>Joshua 10:25</u> - And Joshua said to them, "Do not be afraid or dismayed; be strong and courageous. For thus the LORD will do to all your enemies against whom you fight."

<u>Joshua 11:6</u> - And the LORD said to Joshua, "Do not be afraid of them, for tomorrow at this time I will give over all of them, slain, to Israel. You shall hamstring their horses and burn their chariots with fire."

<u>Judges 4:18</u> - And Jael came out to meet Sisera and said to him, "Turn aside, my lord; turn aside to me; do not be afraid." So he turned aside to her into the tent, and she covered him with a rug.

<u>1 Samuel 4:20</u> - And about the time of her death the women attending her said to her, "Do not be afraid, for you have borne a son." But she did not answer or pay attention.

- <u>2 Samuel 13:28</u> Then Absalom commanded his servants, "Mark when Amnon's heart is merry with wine, and when I say to you, 'Strike Amnon,' then kill him. Do not fear; have I not commanded you? Be courageous and be valiant."
- <u>1 Kings 17:13</u> And Elijah said to her, "Do not fear; go and do as you have said. But first make me a little cake of it and bring it to me, and afterward make something for yourself and your son.
- <u>2 Kings 17:34</u> To this day they do according to the former manner. They do not fear the LORD, and they do not follow the statutes or the rules or the law or the commandment that the LORD commanded the children of Jacob, whom he named Israel.
- <u>Psalm 55:19</u> God will give ear and humble them, he who is enthroned from of old, Selah because they do not change and do not fear God.
- <u>Isaiah 7:4</u> And say to him, 'Be careful, be quiet, do not fear, and do not let your heart be faint because of these two smoldering stumps of firebrands, at the fierce anger of Rezin and Syria and the son of Remaliah.
- <u>Isaiah 8:12</u> "Do not call conspiracy all that this people calls conspiracy, and do not fear what they fear, nor be in dread.
- <u>Isaiah 57:11</u> Whom did you dread and fear, so that you lied, and did not remember me, did not lay it to heart? Have I not held my peace, even for a long time, and you do not fear me?
- <u>Jeremiah 42:11</u> Do not fear the king of Babylon, of whom you are afraid. Do not fear him, declares the LORD, for I am with you, to save you and to deliver you from his hand.

<u>Lamentations 3:57</u> - You came near when I called on you; you said, 'Do not fear!'

Malachi 3:5 - "Then I will draw near to you for judgment. Matthew 1:20 - But as he considered these things, behold, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream, saying, "Joseph, son of David, do not fear to take Mary as your wife, for that which is conceived in her is from the Holy Spirit.

Matthew 10:28 - And do not fear those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul. Rather fear him who can destroy both soul and body in hell.

Mark 5:36 - But overhearing what they said, Jesus said to the ruler of the synagogue, "Do not fear, only believe."

<u>Luke 8:50</u> - But Jesus on hearing this answered him, "Do not fear; only believe, and she will be well."

<u>Luke 12:4</u> - "I tell you, my friends, do not fear those who kill the body, and after that have nothing more that they can do.

<u>1 Peter 3:6</u> - as Sarah obeyed Abraham, calling him lord. And you are her children, if you do good and do not fear anything that is frightening.

Revelation 2:10 - Do not fear what you are about to suffer. Behold, the devil is about to throw some of you into prison, that you may be tested, and for ten days you will have tribulation. Be faithful unto death, and I will give you the crown of life.

## DO NOT BE ANXIOUS (8)

Matthew 6:31 - Therefore do not be anxious, saying, 'What shall we eat?' or 'What shall we drink?' or 'What shall we wear?'

<u>Matthew 6:34</u> - "Therefore do not be anxious about tomorrow, for tomorrow will be anxious for itself. Sufficient for the day is its own trouble.

Matthew 10:19 - When they deliver you over, do not be anxious how you are to speak or what you are to say, for what you are to say will be given to you in that hour.

Mark 13:11 - And when they bring you to trial and deliver you over, do not be anxious beforehand what you are to say, but say whatever is given you in that hour, for it is not you who speak, but the Holy Spirit.

<u>Luke 12:11</u> - And when they bring you before the synagogues and the rulers and the authorities, do not be anxious about how you should defend yourself or what you should say,

<u>Luke 12:22</u> - And he said to his disciples, "Therefore I tell you, do not be anxious about your life, what you will eat, nor about your body, what you will put on.

<u>Philippians 4:6</u> - do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God.
