This scholarship is dedicated to empowering survivors of domestic violence through education. Each year, we recognize outstanding individuals who have demonstrated resilience and determination in overcoming the challenges posed by domestic violence.

Award

- Scholarship Amount: \$500
- Opens January 6th each year
- Number of Scholarships: Determined by March each year
- Honoree Invitation: Each recipient will be honored at our Annual Domestic Violence Awareness Luncheon

Eligibility Requirements

- Undergraduate student or prospective student entering college/university by Fall Semester
- Personally affected by domestic violence
- Volunteer experience with domestic violence
- Minimum 2.5 GPA

Application Deadline

- Applications must be submitted by midnight on Saturday, April 26, 2025

Notification of Award

- Award notifications will be completed between June 22nd and June 28th, 2025
- Proof of enrollment in a college/university must be submitted before the award is made

Required Documents

1. Application Form
2. Personal Statement:
 - Page 1: How domestic violence impacted your education

- Page 2: How this scholarship will impact your future
- 3. Two Professional Letters of Recommendation
- 4. Community Service Verification:
 - 60 hours at a Domestic Violence Center
- 5. Official Transcripts:
 - High School Seniors: Submit high school transcript
 - College Students: Submit most recent college transcript
 - New Students without a transcript: Submit a short story explaining why you are unable to provide a transcript

Application Process Overview

1. Review the eligibility requirements.
2. Complete the application form.
3. Write your personal statement and gather your letters of recommendation.
4. Complete your community service hours and obtain verification.
5. Collect your official transcripts.
6. Mail all required documents to the address provided.

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

- Who is eligible to apply for the scholarship? Applicants must be personally affected by domestic violence, have volunteer experience with domestic violence, and hold a minimum 2.5 GPA.
- Can I apply if I am a high school senior? Yes, high school seniors who will be entering college/university by the Fall Semester are eligible.
- What should be included in my personal statement? Your personal statement should address how domestic violence impacted your education and how this scholarship will impact your future.

In January of 2023, I was shot in the face by my boyfriend. This incident has made the scholarship even more important to me, highlighting the urgent need to support those affected by domestic violence.
