“Dear [MP’s Name],

I am a constituent writing to raise concerns regarding the Government of Canada Job Bank and its role in facilitating job postings that appear to disadvantage Canadian citizens and permanent residents.

In my job search, I have repeatedly encountered a troubling pattern: administrative roles marketed to Canadians locally often offer wages near \$18–\$22 per hour, while nearly identical Office Administrator positions on the federal Job Bank advertise wages of \$35–\$37.50 per hour and explicitly allow temporary residents with work permits to apply.

Despite meeting the qualifications and applying to these higher-wage positions, I have received no responses. This raises serious concerns that some postings may exist primarily to support LMIA applications or employer incentives rather than to fill genuine labour shortages.

I respectfully request that your office seek clarification from Employment and Social Development Canada on:

- How Job Bank postings are monitored for genuine local recruitment
- Whether public funds or incentives are tied to these wage levels
- How fairness for Canadian workers is being protected

I would appreciate your assistance in ensuring transparency and accountability in a system funded by Canadian taxpayers.
