



Common Dental Implant Maintenance Procedure Codes

- **D6080**- Implant maintenance procedure where there is removal of a full fixed screw retained hybrid denture: includes cleaning of the prosthesis & abutments; debridement of implants; examination and assessment of the implant system and components; providing patient home care instructions and reinserting the prosthesis.
- **D6180**- Implant maintenance procedures when a full fixed screw retained hybrid denture is NOT removed: involves cleaning the prosthesis; biofilm disruption around abutments; and patient home care instructions.
- **D6280**- Implant maintenance procedures when a full arch removable implant/abutment supported denture (NOT screw retained) is removed: includes cleansing of the prosthesis & abutments; debridement of implants; examination and assessment of the implant system and components; providing patient home care instructions and reinserting the prosthesis.
- **D6049**- Non-Surgical scaling and debridement of a single implant in the presence of peri-implantitis (bone loss), bleeding upon probing and increased pocket depths: includes cleaning of the implant surfaces without flap entry and closure.
- **D6081**- Non-Surgical scaling and debridement in the presence of inflammation or mucositis (NO bone loss) of a single implant: includes cleaning of the implant surfaces without flap entry and closure.
- **D6101, 6102, 6103, and 6104** are variations of SURGICAL interventions.

The above are all summary descriptions of CDT codes and are not exact verbiage of the descriptors. They are listed here to provide clarity of which procedure is indicated and is not a guarantee of coverage based on 2026 updates.
