

B-26 MARAUDER HISTORICAL SOCIETY 2018 REUNION - COLORADO SPRINGS August 1-4, 2018

Old acquaintances, new friends, fascinating talks, and sites you cannot see anywhere else—that's what you will experience at this year's MHS Reunion! Second generation member Nick Cressy has put together three days of not-to-be-forgotten events. Plus, there are pre—and post-reunion options to go along with one of the country's most attractive and exciting settings. Extend your stay to see all that Colorado Springs has to offer.

We will tour the United States Air Force Academy, from its architecturally-stunning chapel to the memorial cemetery with monuments dedicated to Marauder units. We dine at the swank Falcon Club. During our excursion, you'll drive through the amazing Garden of the Gods—rock formations unlike any you have ever seen.

Keeping up our reunion tradition of outstanding museum experiences, this year we will have an expert tour of the National Museum of WWII Aviation, where Nick is a docent. We begin prior to public opening, providing an uncrowded and exclusive opportunity. The museum features an aircraft collection, exhibits, interactive displays, telling the story of our nation's tremendous technological advancements during the War, and describing the lasting social and economic changes that were essential to the success of the Allied war effort.

Nick has also arranged for a tour of the next-door WestPac Restorations operation. WestPac is a full service aircraft restoration and maintenance facility that prides itself as one of the most efficient restoration facilities in the U.S. The WestPac team has help to restore an AD-6, a P-38, a P-51, a P-47, an F4U-4 and an F-7F. As a bonus, we'll hear a presentation on propellers, including those used on the Marauder.

The 2018 lineup of speakers, panels, and discussions is first class! Once again, the headline event is our first generation panel. Hear from those who were there about life with the B-26 Marauder. For the first time, we expect a 3rd generation member in our "descendants" panel. Ron Bolesta will present his research on B-26 POWs. We'll have a restoration update, perhaps the largest ever! And there's more, including Reunion chair Nick Cressy on the 1st Tactical Air Force, and an address from the President of the Museum of WWII Aviation.



Transportation and Housing

The host hotel for the 2018 Reunion is the Colorado Springs Marriott, a convenient, full-service hotel with beautiful mountain views. It is located at 5580 Tech Center Drive, 719-260-1800. There is a full-service restaurant, a swimming pool, a workout room, and a lounge in the hotel. In-room Wi-Fi is free, and parking is free. MHS has arranged for a discount rate of \$12+tax per person for the daily, extensive breakfast buffet for all guests attending our reunion.

To make your hotel room reservation at the Colorado Springs Marriott, go online to www.goo.gl/C4ctTh (case-sensitive) or call, 800-932-2151 and mention you would like a room in the B-26 MHS room block to take advantage of the special Reunion rates. Rates are: \$129 per night for single, double, triple or quad occupancy. *The group rate is available after July 2, 2018 only upon hotel determination of availability.* The hotel will honor our group room rate beginning July 29 and extending to August 6, if space is available.

The airport nearest to the Marriott is Colorado Springs (COS), with Denver International (DEN) within 75 minutes.
