The book, entitled :A Guide to Research Sources, compiled by: Esther M. Oyster and John O. Moench M/G (RET) and sponsored by The B-26 Marauder Historical Society, ISBN 1-877597-03-1, and continues to serve as the major source for Marauder information. It was published in 1992 and replaced the Martin B-26 Marauder and Bibliography ISBN I-877597-02-3 that was published in 1990. It is time to determine what might have been published since then. Your help is needed to find these newer tomes.

Do you know if someone in your Group/Squadron published its history? Let MHS know, the title and authorship and when published. Do you know if there are extra copies still available?

Kindly forward the information on your Unit if it still meeting, i.e. current Officers, e mail addresses and scheduled date for your Unit's reunion in 2011.
