Description and Acknowledgement of Risks

The Parties understand and acknowledge that:

The Activities have foreseeable and unforeseeable inherent risks, hazards, and dangers that no amount of care, caution or expertise can eliminate, including without limitation, the potential for serious bodily injury, permanent disability, paralysis, and loss of

The Organization may offer or promote online programming (such as webinars, remote conferences, workshops, and online training) which have different foreseeable and unforeseeable risks than in-person

The Organization has a difficult task to ensure safety and it is not infallible, the Organization may be unaware of the

Participant's fitness or abilities, may give incomplete warnings or instructions, may misjudge weather or environmental conditions, and the equipment being used might malfunction; and

Physical contact with other participants (including spotters).

Not wearing appropriate safety or protective equipment.

Failure to act safely or within the Participant's ability or designated areas. Negligence of other persons, including other spectators, participants, or employees; and

Travel to and from competitive events and associated non-competitive events which are an integral part of the Activities

In consideration of the Organization allowing the Participant to participate in the Activities, the Parties agree:

That when the Participant practices or trains in their own space, the Parties are responsible for the Participant's surroundings and the location and equipment that is selected for the Participant.

That the Participant's mental and physical condition is appropriate to participate in the Activities and the Parties assume all risks related to the Participant's mental and

That the Participant may experience anxiety while challenging themselves during the

To comply with the rules and regulations for participation in the

To comply with the rules of the facility or

That if the Participant observes an unusual significant hazard or risk, the Participant will remove themselves from participation and bring their observations to a representative of the Organization

The risks associated with the Activities are increased when the Participant is impaired, and the Participant will not participate if impaired in any way.

That it is their sole responsibility to assess whether any Activities are too difficult for the By the Participant commencing an Activity, they acknowledge and accept the suitability and conditions of the Activity.

That COVID-19 is contagious in nature and the Participant may be exposed to, or infected by, COVID-19 and such exposure may result in personal injury, illness, permanent disability, or loss of life; and

The Parties agree that in the event that they file a lawsuit against the Organization, they agree to do so solely in the Province of Ontario and they further agree that the substantive law of the Province of Ontario will apply without regard to conflict of law
