Dancers who win 3 - 1st place Preliminary Championships in one calendar year must move into Open January 1st of the following year or as soon as the 3rd win is achieved in the following years.

Girls and Boys are combined. Soft shoe danced first. 3 dancers up to and including Under 14 and 2 in age groups above.
