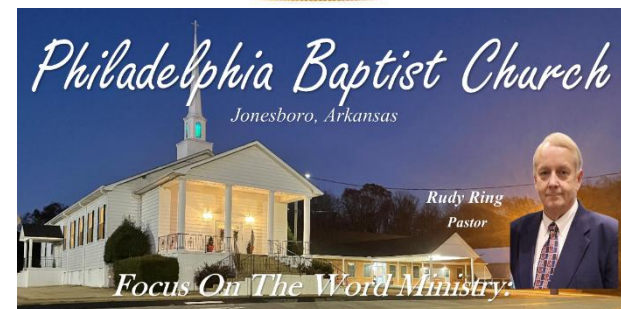

Parents should place this sign next to the T.V. Set.

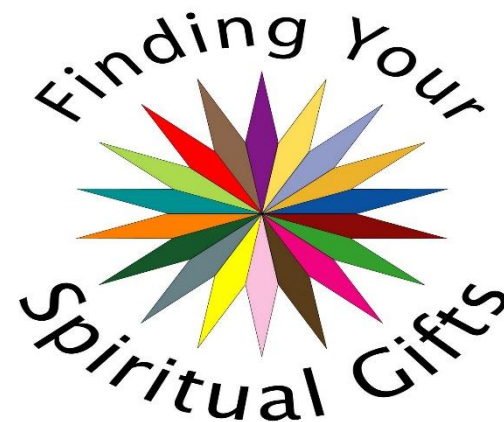
