Chaplains Corner February 2025

Yesterday I watched one of the more recent Marine battles, and one of the grunts was explaining what was happening in a house that he needed to clear. There were a lot of enemy upstairs, coming for him, and he realized he wasn't going to make it out. But during a lull in the shooting, he chose to be grateful that he was alive at that moment, and how precious that next breath was. He didn't panic, nor was he hopeless, but focused on that next breath.

What is OUR enemy just upstairs? Health, wealth, career, relationships, eternity? We are Marines, we are alive, and no matter what, we can focus on how precious that next breath is. How much hope is in that next breath?

And not just for us, but for all veterans. The latest VA report showed that the suicide rate in general went down from 22 per day to 18! Age 18-34 decreased 15%, 35-54 dropped 8%. But we old salts INCREASED by nearly 9%. We are winning this battle, but are still charged to win the war.

Let us cherish each breath, for us, and encourage each other to do the same.
